This Deed made this 29th day of January 1816 between Luther P. Edwards
(Sister) Mary A. Bramant and D. P. Bramant grantees of the County of Southhampton
State of Virginia, of the first part, and Thomas Johnson of the same County and
Stafford the second part. Whereas: that in consideration of the sum of one hundred
thirty seven & 5/100 dollars paid by the said Thomas Johnson the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged, they the said Luther P. Edwards, Mary A. and D. P. Bramant
do bargain, sell and grant with general warranty, the following real property
to wit: a certain parcel or lot of land lying in the aforesaid County of Southhampton,
State of Virginia, and bounded as follows, to wit: North by the lands of Henry A.
Bramant East by the lot belonging to Samuel Brandon, South by R. Williams and
James land, and West by Luther P. Edwards land, containing by survey five
and half acre. Witness the following signature and seal
