

This Deed made this 10th day of June 1776, between Oliver Deles and Joseph his wife of the one part and Robert H. Deles of the other part, all the County of Southampton State of Virginia, Testifyeth: that in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and Twelve Dollars, (\$112.00) the parties of the first part, did give and sell unto Oliver H. Deles, party of the second part, all of their right, title and interest with general warranty to a certain tract or parcel of land lying in Southampton County, containing fifty four acres or less, siting the same to purchase of Edward J. Rogers, Victoria, Thomas and Alexander Simonsen, Thomas line of Nathan Johnson do: and bounded on the North and West by Robert Hill Swamp, on the South by Thomas Savage Road, on the East by George Jones as before said. The parties of the aforesaid, did give the title and as above mentioned.
