This Agreement entered into this 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1876, between Geo. J. Dondert of the first part, and Joseph C. Reddy of the other part, witnesses: That the said Geo. J. Dondert is about to engage in the cultivation of the said land, and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1876, from the said Dondert for the amount of one hundred dollars, and the said Geo. J. Dondert having agreed, on his part, to furnish said supplies, now the said J. C. Reddy, on his part, and in consideration of the above promised, do hereby grant a lien to the said Geo. J. Dondert on all the crops that he made on his land which is devoted to J. C. Reddy, and Geo. A. Schult, the year 1876 for the above amount of advances, which has been or was intended to have been advanced, and it is further agreed between the parties, that the said crops shall be sold as soon as they are ready to be sold, or before the 15<sup>th</sup> of Nov. next to the said Geo. J. Dondert, he to sell at any time after the above date, and turn over the balance of any sale to J. C. Reddy. This Lien is granted with and of the General Specialty of Virginia, approved April 3<sup>rd</sup> 1876, entitled an act to secure the advances for agricultural purposes, being the following signature and seal.

This Agreement entered into this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of May 1876, between Geo. H. Sinner and W. J. Sinner, merchants and grocers, trading under the firm name of Sinner and Geo. H. Sinner, of the one part, and J. B. Sinner of the other part, witnesses: That the said Geo. H. Sinner is about to engage in the cultivation of the said land, and is desirous to obtain during the year 1876, advances, in money or supplies, from the said Sinner for the amount of fifty dollars, beyond which the said Geo. H. Sinner shall not go, and the said Sinner now having agreed, on their part, to furnish the said advances, now the said J. B. Sinner, on his part, in consideration of the above promised, do hereby grant a lien to the said Sinner, now on the crops that may be made during the year 1876, upon the land in the cultivation of
