

This 2nd made the seventeenth day of March A. D. 1860 between Adelst H. Cawthon of the
one part, and Dr. J. Schell, Doctor of the other part, witnesseth: That the said Adelst H.
Cawthon did grant unto the said Dr. J. Schell Doctor the following property, to wit: his
crop of corn, fodder, cotton and peaseants now growing on land to secure the payment of a
debt due David Esteban by note of \$200.00 dated March 17th 1860.

This Agreement entered into this 17th day of March 1860 between Dr. J. Pritchett of the
first part and Dr. J. Schell Doctor of the other part, witnesseth: That whereas
the said Adelst H. Cawthon is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous
to obtain supplies during the year 1860 from the said Doctor for the amount of one
hundred dollars and the summing the aforesaid beyond which amount the said Cawthon
shall not go; and the said Dr. J. Pritchett having agreed on his part to furnish
such supplies, so he said J. J. Schell is to pay and in consideration of the above
agreement, has hereby granted to Dr. J. Pritchett on all the crops that may
make out his hand which is estimated to Dr. J. Pritchett this year
1860 for the above amount of advances which has been or will be estimated to have been
advanced, and it is further agreed between the parties, that the said crops shall be
valued at Second Dimes per bushel before the 15th of June next, & the said Dr. J.
Pritchett to sell it for the above debt and taxes over the balance of any crop &c. I.
H. Cawthon Dr. J. Pritchett is granted with the General Assembly of Virginia
approved April 2^d 1862, entitled and acts to secure the advances for agricultural

and Mr. J. Turner, merchant and postmaster, trading under the firm name of Turner
and Son of the first, and Dr. J. Schell Doctor of the other part, witnesseth: That whereas
the said Dr. J. Schell is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous
to obtain during the year 1860 advanced, at money, or supplies, from the said Dr. H. Turner
the sum amounts of Fifty Dollars, beyond which limit the said Dr. H. Turner
shall not go; and the said Turner are having agreed, in their part, to furnish
the said advanced, with the said Dr. J. Schell on his part, in consideration of the
above promised, that hereby grants a land to the said Dr. H. Turner on the crops
which may be made during the year 1860 upon the land in the cultivation of
