The Deed of Bargain and Sale from Robert Stevens to Elizabeth Phillips, was this day signed and acknowledged by said Stevens to be his act and deed, and admitted to record.

The Deed made this 15th day of July 1876 between Elizabeth Phillips, of the first part, and Rich'd. Stevens of the second part, citizen of Southampton and State of Virginia, Testifying that she with party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and fifty dollars, lawful money to her paid, by the said Rich'd. Stevens, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath given, bargained sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Rich'd. Stevens a certain piece or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton, State of Virginia and bounded to certaine derty acres, more or less, being the same tract of land which was conveyed to the said Elizabeth Phillips by Deed of Bargain and Sale duly recorded, in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County, on the 25th day of December 1857, by John H. Stanley, for a more particular description of which, reference to said Deed is hereby specially made. Dated the following signature and seal.

The Deed of Bargain and Sale from Elizabeth Phillips to Rich'd. Stevens was this day signed and sealed by the hands of David Dennis and Tanner R. Story, two subscribing witnesses, and admitted to record.

The Deed made the 18th day of July in the year 1876, between Rich'd. Stevens of the first and Rich'd. A. Darden, trustee of the other party, Testifying that the said Rich'd. A. Darden did grant unto the said Rich'd. Stevens all of his personal property, including his house, dogs, farming implements, etc. &c. to the trust to receive a sum of Fifty Dollars with interest until paid dated the 5th day of May 1876, given to Rich'd. A. Darden the beneficiary of the debt. It is agreed between the parties that no sale shall take place under this debt until payment thereof is given of land and place of same.
