

This Deed made and entered into this 17th day of July 1876 of between Joseph L. Self of the one part and Oscar White of the other part, witnesseth that the said Joseph L. Self doth grant and convey to the said Oscar White all his interests in and title of land containing by estimation ten acres more or less, and bounded by the lands of Elbert Griffith Suttle Lawrence, Rockingham and others, as trust to secure the payment of and land due to Hester Peasehouse bearing date the 17th of July 1876 for the sum of twenty five dollars, of the said Oscar L. Self fail to pay the amount of such land to the said Hester Peasehouse, then the said Oscar White shall have no interest in all such land & his highness' holder for cash and pay to the said Peasehouse all that may be due on such land and the surplus if any to such self after due notice of time and place of sale. This Deed of Land from Oscar L. Self to Oscar White made for the benefit of Hester Peasehouse was this day received and acknowledged by said Self to be his act and deed and admitted to record.

This Deed made this 29th day of June 1876, between Henry A. Jordan of the one part, Hendrick H. Clayton (Deuter) of the other part, all of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, Whereas I, that Henry A. Jordan of the first dek stand unto Hendrick H. Clayton (Deuter), as aforesaid, all of her eight title and interest, in trust as aforesaid to the said Hendrick H. Clayton to a certain tract of land lying in the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, containing two hundred and four acres and more or less, sit being the land on which the two hundred and four acres stand more or less, sit being the land on which the said Henry A. Jordan now resides bounded by the lands of Mr. S. P. Kite, Benjamin Foster, Mr. & Mrs. W. Smith and others, to secure a sum of Eight Hundred and forty four dollars and from costs, dated this day and payable twelve months after date. This deed is given in consideration in part of a former debt so due which above the aforesaid sum of Eight hundred and forty four dollars and from costs, shall be paid when all obligation to the date, at a sum equal with all of the aforesaid sum of \$844 to be paid when it shall become due, and the aforesaid debts to be paid and paid, otherwise Hendrick H. Clayton, he, that this allegation to be paid and paid, otherwise Hendrick H. Clayton Deuter or his successors will after giving legal notice, proceed to sell the aforesaid tract of land on that furnished for costs, first pay all charges attending the sale, then pay the aforesaid debt and interest, the remainder pay to my son, A. Jordan or his legal representative. Dated my hand and seal the day above written.
