This Deed of Debt made this 1st day of August 1876, between
Elijah Parker, the grantor of the first part, and H. D. Schell, the
Deutor of the second part. Whereas, that for and in consideration
of one hundred dollars paid to the party of the first part, the receipt
of which is hereby acknowledged, the party of the first part do
grant and Convey unto the said H. D. Schell the Deutre the following
property to wit: All the Crops of every description growing and to be
planted and grown by the said Elijah Parker upon the farm or lands
so more fully being part of the State Plantation formerly during the
year 1870, the tract of land and entire interest in stock of hogs.
In trust however to James Daniel Mr. Corlett of Roanoke Va. for advances
made to said Elijah Parker to enable him to carry on his former
operations or also named lands for the year 1876. This Deed unto the
hundred and twenty one thousand, dated 1st January 1876, and for
open account due the sum of One hundred dollars, it being for grain
and other supplies furnished said Elijah Parker of the first part
by the said James Mr. Corlett. It is further agreed by all the parties
to this writing, that if the said Elijah Parker shall fail or die before
the 1st day of January 1877, to pay the said debts then the Deuter shall
have the privilege after giving ten days notice at those just places
in said County, sell all the property herein Conveyed for cash and
out of the proceeds pay said debts interest and costs, also fee for
Court Commission to the said trustee and balance of such funds, if any
pay over to the said Elijah Parker or his assigns.
