

Deputy and Public Justice as aforesaid, to be their act and deed. And on the 3^d day of August 1876, the law aforesaid, by law, having been put into adoption to record.

This Bond of Debt made this 1st day of August 1876, between Elijah Parker the grantor of the first part, and W. H. Edwards, the Justice of the peace of the first part, that for and in consideration of two dollars in hand paid to the party of the first part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the party of the first part do grant and convey unto the said W. H. Edwards the Justice the following property to wit: all the crops of every description growing and to be planted and grown by the said Elijah Parker upon the place on which he now resides, being part of the John Whitehead farm, during the year 1876, also stock of Cattle and swine situated on tract of land. On trust however to require Samuel M. Corliss of Virginia 1st of Adams ward to said Elijah Parker to enable him to carry on his farming operations on other named lands for the year 1876. To pay over unto the hundred and twenty one Ten dollars, dated 1st January 1876, and for open account due this day of two hundred dollars, all being for grain and other supplies, furnished said Elijah Parker of the first part by the said Samuel M. Corliss. It is further agreed by all the parties to this writing, that if the said Elijah Parker shall fail on or before the 1st day of January 1877 to pay the said debt then the Justice shall have the privilege after giving ten days notice at three public places in said County, to sell all the property herein conveyed for cash and out of the proceeds pay said debt, interest and costs, also fees for said Commission to the said Justice and balance of such proceeds, if any, pay over to the said Elijah Parker or his assigns.
