1. I, Thos. D. Pittston, son, lately died in the County of Southampton,
State of Virginia, intestate and seized and possessed of large and valuable real estate
among which is his old farm which lies on the west side of the County road
which leads from Derville to Berlin, and usually called the Derville and Smithfield
road and including about four acres on the west side of said road, near the junction
of the above named road and the old Berlin and Derville road towards the old field
house in the direction of Berlin, which old farm is bounded by several farms
and which land is bounded north by the lands of Elijah Pittston, & L. Pittston and
G. H. Pittston; east by the lands of Mrs. H. Pugett and A. Gorrie Pittston; south
by said A. Gorrie Pittston, and West by the said Derville and Smithfield roads
and including the small piece of about five acres or thereabouts. And whereas the
said Thos. D. Pittston, left at his house at last to show the said land described,
his four children to wit: Mr. Thos. D. Pittston Jr., John Gorrie Pittston, Carolina R. wife of
John Pittston Jr., and Annie A. Rose, wife of the Rev. Thos. D. Pittston A. Hart,
And whereas it has been agreed to by them between the said parties, to sell to the
said A. Gorrie Pittston the land above described for the sum of one hundred and twelve
dollars per acre, and to pay to the said Thos. D. Pittston Jr. and Mr. Thos. D. Pittston Jr. as
attenuated of the said Thos. D. Pittston, less 10% to be held by them as a part
of their hands to be disposed of at other parts of such attenuated estate.
Therefore the said Pittston made this 3rd day of March, One thousand eight hundred
and forty six between the said Thos. D. Pittston Jr. and Annie A. Hart wife, John
Pittston Jr. and Carolina R. his wife, and Rev. Thos. D. Pittston and Annie A. Pittston
wife of the said Pittston, and the said A. Gorrie Pittston, of the said first. WITNESSETH
that the said parties of the first part, do, in Consideration of the said sum of one thousand
dollars, paid with general warranty, unto the said A. Gorrie Pittston,
and to his heirs and assigns forever, the land described as aforesaid, and containing
an estimated twelve hundred acres, more or less, that is to say, where unenclosed
lands thereof, (the said A. Gorrie Pittston being by his wife entitled to the same
portion). together with all and singular the appurtenances belonging to the same,
