This Agreement made and entered into this 15th day of July, 1876, between D. L. Griffith, Merchant of the first part, and Joseph Whitehead (Ct.), of the second, witnesses, as follows: That whereas the said Joseph Whitehead is engaged in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1876 from the said D. L. Griffith for the sum of Forty five dollars, he has agreed to shall not go and the said D. L. Griffith having agreed to furnish said supplies. And the said Whitehead on his part and in consideration of the above advances and promises has hereby given a bond to the said D. L. Griffith on all the crops of the said Whitehead during the year 1876 upon the land of which the said Whitehead is tenant for the sum of the above advances and the cost of this Agreement. And it is further more agreed by the parties to this deed that the said Crop shall be delivered to the said D. L. Griffith on or before the 1st day of Nov. 1876, and that 25 per cent of said Crop is to be sold until it is by each of the said D. L. Griffith until this agreement is satisfied. This Lien is granted under and out of the General Assembly of N. Carolina April 27th 1873 entitled and act to secure advances for agricultural purposes.
