The Deed made this 11<sup>th</sup> day of August in the year 1876, between Henry Bradford of the first part and Mr. J. Sondor, Doctor of the second part, witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars to have and to hold paid to the said Henry Bradford party of the first part, deck gear, traps, traps, etc and money unto the said Mr. J. Sondor, Doctor all of his right, title and interest in and to all of the following property to wit: All of the Crops of every description now growing on the farm which the said Henry Bradford rented of Doctor J. Sondor for the year 1876, consisting of Corn, Cotton, Stock, feed and such pasture land being Cultivated by the said Bradford in the said farm, rented from the said Harrison, also all of his household and kitchen furniture of every description, together with all of his right title and interest in all of his logs and fanning implements on said farm or elsewhere belonging to him. In trust to secure unto Doctor J. Sondor and Mr. J. Pease the payment of two several notes to be paid to them without parol, under the following description, viz: One note for the sum of Fifty dollars bearing date on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August 1876 and payable on demand to the said Doctor J. Sondor, and one note for the sum of Fifty two 52<sup>nd</sup> to be concurred by the said Bradford and bearing date on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August 1876, and payable on demand to Mr. Pease, and the said party of the first part shall remain liable to make default and fail to pay the two aforesaid notes after reasonable demand for the same then the said Doctor shall after due publication of time and place of sale sell all his further interest in the property herein mentioned and apply the proceeds thereof to the trust created by this Deed.
