

Know all men by these presents, that I, Parker of this County of Southampton Virginia, in Consideration of the sum of Sixty Seven and 50 pence dollars, advanced me by Dr. C. H. Wickham, for Supplies, Machineries &c, as shewd by the bills and accounts for the same, do sell unto Conroy unto him, the following property, to-wit: One bed, iron Cooker, also my Coffe of Cotton, presents and brandy made in the year 1776. So Davis and Held to him, the greater, and his heirs or assigns forever & warrant the property free of all incumbrances, and fully of such the night.

It is agreed however, that if I, the grantor, or my representatives, pay unto Dr. C. H. Wickham or his representatives, the sum above named, on or before the 1st day of December 1776, in redemption for this property, and until such payment shall not make attorney, receiver, or remove the same, and in case of injury or death leave any debts of any sort, bonds or bills, that Onderwood held myself, their said attorney responsible for the full value thereof, retaining all remitted amounts, then these presents, and every thing herein contained, shall cease and be void. Otherwise, remains in force and effect. On default in the foregoing Condition, the Grantee or his representatives, may sue the above party at action, at any time, after two days notice to the grantor, obtaining the sum of money recd above, & all cost and charges of the suit, and during the damages of any to the grantor or his representatives. It is agreed also, that until default of these Conditions, the grantee may stand possessed of the property, and that the grantor or his representatives, may purchase at any sale made as aforesaid.

H. Grady to me - have granted, bargained and alsevered unto the said C. H. Grady now, a certain judgment, Court held by H. A.
