

Agreed and sworn, viz. (Ctgs) in money, provisions, seed and supplies to be such
the amount of fifty dollars \$50. to enable him the said Saml Warren (Ct) to cultivate a
Crop or Crops on the lands of S. A. Clayton in the County of Southampton. Consisting of
Corn, peas, potatoes, potatoes, Cotton &c. during the year 1796. and returned the said
Richd. A. Clayton has this day agreed to (or signified by the signing of these presents)
to make with the said Saml Warren (Ct) the advance so desired, that is to say,
money, provisions, seed and supplies to enable the said Saml Warren (Ct) to cultivate
the Crops or a Crop, aforesaid, not to exceed the sum of fifty dollars \$50. during the
year (1796) for the said Saml Warren (Ct) in consideration of the advance to be made
by the said Richd. A. Clayton, do hereby grant unto the said Richd. A. Clayton
his heirs or assigns a lien on any and all the Crops which the said Saml Warren (Ct)
may cultivate during the year 1796. Consisting of Corn, fodder, peas, potatoes,
Cotton and potatoes to be which things as much as may pay to satisfy the said Richd.
A. Clayton for all the advance which he may make to the said Saml Warren (Ct)
during the year 1796 not to exceed fifty dollars \$50. aforesaid and the said Saml
Warren (Ct) do by these presents relinquish all claim, right and title to any and
all of the said Crops and the said Richd. A. Clayton his heirs or assigns, and it
is distinctly agreed between the parties (the said Saml Warren (Ct) and Richd. A.
Clayton) that the advance made under this Contract by the said Richd. A. Clayton
to the said Saml Warren (Ct) shall be fully satisfied out of the Crops aforesaid
on or before the first day of December 1796. Witness the following signatures

Whereas, by a decree of the Circuit Court of Southampton County, made on the
day of November, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy three,
in the said then pending, wherein S. A. Schell, R. A. Bell and S. A. Bell
were plaintiffs and S. A. Schell and others are defendants, it was decreed and
ordered that the S. A. Schell, Sheriff &c. (as was appointed, for that purpose),
should sell the said land of S. A. Schell, in the sum and conditions
