Tyler, Deputee of the several justices of the peace for the County of Switzerland, and Caroline A. Austin debt grossly made to the said James R. Tyler and guarantors, whereby a parcel of land containing ninety nine (99) lying in Switzerland, belonging to the said James R. Tyler and for the consideration of money is made to the said James R. Tyler of Switzerland to Joseph S. Parham of New York, of the County of Dutchess, and fifty two cents, and it is hereby stipulated and agreed by all parties to this deed to wit: David Austin, Caroline A. Austin, James R. Tyler and Wm. Shanks, that the said Deutor shall sell the said land, publicly or privately as to him may seem best and on such terms as he may think best, and out of the purchase money, after paying the cost of this deed including a Commission of five per cent to the Deutor, pay to Wm. Shanks first the sum of twenty nine dollars and fifty two cents and the residue of the purchase money, pay two thirds to Caroline A. Austin and the other third to Wm. Shanks.
