Not Dated made this 17th day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty six between William H. H. Davis, Justice of the County of Isle of Wight Virginia of the first part, Samuel P. Butler Notary for H. S. Deasy of the County of Southampton, Deacon of the second part, and Deborah Butcher of the County and State last aforesaid of the third part, Whereas by a Deed of Trust dated the eighth day of April 1871 and of record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County, the said Deborah Butcher party of the third part, in article second to our said Deed gave the payment of a certain Bond for the sum of Fifty four hundred dollars, executed by the said Deborah Butcher and payable to the said H. S. Deasy bearing date in the 1st day of April 1869, did convey unto the said H. S. Deasy Certain Real Estate situate, situated and described as said and set as follows; all that tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Isle of Wight Virginia commonly known as "Mall Hill" situated & containing one thousand and fifty and more or less, in the tract of land heretofore granted by David J. Carter to the said David and his wife Anna Carter, and the acts of it afterwards granted by the said David to the said Susan Carter by David J. Carter and said land are bounded by the lands belonging to the Estate of the late Dr. J. H. Carpenter and the lands formerly owned by the late Drayton C. Wilson and H. S. Deasy. And whereas the said H. S. Deasy did in the eighth day of April 1871 assign for value received the aforesaid Bond to James Martin Varnish, Esq. and afterwards married with J. J. Carter and deceased on the 24th day of March 1876. The said J. J. Carter by and with the consent of his wife and with authority from her in writing, as will be seen by her letter appurtenant, did, for values received, assign said Bond to Samuel P. Butler Notary for H. S. Deasy aforesaid deceased. And whereas the said Bond had been fully paid and satisfied by the receipt of a new Bond by the said Deborah Butcher and payable to the said Samuel P. Butler Notary for H. S. Deasy, the payment of which is secured by a judgment Bond of Death on the said "Mall Hill" farm; and whereas the said Deborah Butcher aforesaid property to be leased to him from the aforesaid David Carter to whom he were the payment of the said bond. Now therefore, the said H. S. Deasy that the said William H. H. Davis in consideration of the premises and by and with the consent of the said Samuel P. Butler Notary for H. S. Deasy, leaving a party to this deed and signing and sealing the same, doth give, grant, release and convey unto the said Deborah Butcher,
