This Deed of Bond made this 19th day of September 1796 between Charles E. Bryant of the first party and Rufus E. Darden Justice of the second party and the heirs of his named son of the third party, Wethersfield: That in consideration of the heretofore named sum paid to the said Charles E. Bryant by himself and others with general concurrence to the said Rufus E. Darden Justice at present by following property, to wit: The interest in land which remained in a tract of land made by the said Charles E. Bryant to Walter Mayette Jr Justice for the benefit of George H. Dimes which said tract was recorded in the record of September 1796 as in book of large account tract, also tract of land, second or eight together with my other chattels etc. to his said tract is not included in the said tract to the said Wethersfield in trust to receive one third the sum paid by Darden for forty six dollars and eighty cents due to same, and freight bill for thirty five cents and two dollars and fifty cents for removing said said land and one hundred and Darden and Mayette for ten dollars and twenty four cents dated the 1st day of August 1796, the another tract the Darden and Mayette for eight hundred and fifty nine cent dated the 19th of September 1796, and it is expressly agreed upon by the parties to the said that if of a sale shall become necessary it shall be for Cash after giving 15 days notice of the same to the Darden take out the Commission and account and pay off the debts above mentioned, of enough and paying over the balance of my's C. E. Bryant or his representatives.
