Sargent on his part and in consideration of the above promises, do hereby grant a bid to the said John C. Brown to on the first which is made during the year 1876, upon the bank of which the above amount of amount has not or intended to have been expended. That said is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 24th 1875, entitled an act to secure advances for agricultural purposes.
