This Deed, made this 9th day of October, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy six between Margaret Ann Wynn, widow of Thomas Wynn Jr. deceased, late of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia, of the first part, and Laura Ann Wynn, of said County and State of the second part, Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars, the said Margaret Ann Wynn doth grant unto the said Laura Ann Wynn with general warranty, all the right, title and interest of the said Margaret Ann Wynn in and to the real estate of which her late husband, the said Thomas Wynn Jr. died, together with the crops, fixtures and lying in the County of Southampton, being her estate of dower in said real estate of the said Thomas Wynn Jr. deceased, which estate she is supposed to contain about four hundred acres of land, to the same more or less, together with her interest in the dwelling house and improvements upon said land, together with all her right of dower, crops and negroes thereunto appertaining during the natural life of her the said Margaret Ann Wynn - it being understood that the estate hereby granted unto the said Laura Ann Wynn is a life estate and not a life estate of the said Margaret Ann Wynn, and the land improvements and principal hereon conveyed and granted unto the said Laura Ann Wynn to be held and enjoyed by her the said Laura Ann Wynn during the lifetime of the said Margaret Ann Wynn, with all the dower of the said Margaret Ann Wynn, go to and to be divided among the heirs at law of the said Thomas Wynn Jr. deceased.
