 before me Daniel H. Lawrence, and Virginia A. his wife of the County of Southampton, and John
 C. H. P. 222 and W. P. Hill, Justices of Brambleton Lodge, in the 23rd S. B. and A. W. of the County of
 Southampton, and State aforesaid of the second part, Who said: that for and in Consideration
 of the sum of eighty seven ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ per Dollars (\$77.50), & when in hand paid, the receipt whereof,
 I hereby acknowledge, the said Daniel H. Lawrence, and Virginia A. his wife, doth grant,
 sell and convey, unto the parties of the second part, and their Successors, the following lot or
 parcel of land, lying on the town of Brambleton, Southampton Co. Va., beginning at a
 point on the 122nd side of Main Street, (91) North and 1/2nd from the corner of Main St. and
 5th Avenue, and running along main St. twenty eight (28) feet, then at right
 angles, a distance of Fifty two and half (52 1/2) feet, thence at right angles in a
 southerly direction, twenty eight (28) feet, and thence in an easterly direction fifty two
 and half feet (52 1/2) feet, to the point of beginning. the same, occupying a certain portion
 on the N. E. side of Main Street, between 5th and 3rd Avenue, containing one
 hundred of an acre, more or less, to have and to hold the same to the said Justice, and their
 Successors forever. And the said Daniel H. Lawrence and Virginia A. his wife, parties of the
 first part, doth warrant generally by these presents, the above named parcel of land,
 with all and singular, the said parties of the first part have therewith or their
