John *His* *Wife* made 2nd day of November 1863 between Corcoran & Salinger, the one first and second wife, husband of the other first, both of the County of Washington and State of Virginia, witnesses that the said Corcoran & Salinger, both hereby grant unto the said second wife, trustee, the following goods and chattels, to-wit: forty barrels of corn, ten pounds of said cotton, five bushels of peas, six solid bush of pebbles and shales, two hams and corn and wheat, one baggy and enough station head of hogs, the sum to secure the foregoing of a certain debt due to John C. Ferguson for the sum of three hundred and sixty five dollars by bond signed by the said Corcoran & Salinger, husband and wife with this debt - but if it should hereafter become necessary to use the said goods and chattels for the foregoing of the said debt, the said trustee shall give of hogs ten dollars value of the said and place of such use, by advertisement posted up at three or more public places in neighborhood, and tell the same to the highest bidder, by cash and other paying off the expense attending the auction of this said debt shall pay the above mentioned debt and interest thereon amounting to and 6666 to C. Ferguson or his legal representatives and the undersigned of us shall be, & the said Corcoran & Salinger, by his order or assigns.
