S. Bristow doth hereby make and give to him by a deed of trust made by James H. Rose and Sarah Rose his wife to secure Adelai Scott and others, due hereby, money to such Benjamin E. Miller such eight, title and interest as are granted to him. The said J. S. Bristow, in trust by said James H. Rose and Sarah Rose his wife, set a certain tract of land on which said Rose and wife lately reside, known as the Emma French Tract, containing 160, one hundred and sixty acres, to the same more or less, and bounded by the lands of C.
