

Imposed at follows, to wit: on the north side of the road leading from Smithsburg to Jefferson, commencing at the center of the cedar swamp, and running from thence along the said country road to the Cedar and Orange Rail road, thence eastwardly along said Rail road to the end of cedar banks, and thence down said swamp to the beginning - whence to which end for a further description of said land it hereby specially made a lot bush, to serve the purposes of a road for the use of One Hundred and Thirty seven dollars, dated on 3rd day of December A.D. - the said amount to R. D. Scott, and whereof said the execution of the above mentioned lot, the debt herein referred to has been fully paid off and discharged, at the rate R. D. Scott hereby acknowledge, evidenced by his signing these presents, and the said James Scott doth and with the above mentioned debt satisfied and remitted to him: Now therefore this third of January with the 24th day of December from James Scott A. D. James Scott, witness as before, and R. D. Scott of the first part, and Testimony of the other part, all of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia, witnesseth: That they, the parties of the first part, both and each of them, hereby release and remit all their rights, title and interest in the said land aforesaid to - to the said Jacob Scott.
