and merchandise to the amount of forty dollars to enable the parties of the second
part to support themselves and families and cultivate their crops for the year 1877.
In consideration whereof the parties of the second part agree and have given a
law upon one lot of land to wit: the lot left when 1855 lb. of the first fishing to be
given by them during the year 1877, and agree to deliver to the parties of the
first part the said lot within at their store house (Brown Town) on or before the 15th
