That the parties of the first part agree to furnish to the parties of the second part, the following supplies to make good some and merchandise to the amount of fifty dollars to enable the parties of the second part to supply themselves and families and cultivate their crop for the year 1877. On consideration whereof the parties of the second part agree and hereby give and bind each other to weigh the best wheat 100 lbs. of the bushels following to be graded by them during the year 1877, and agree to deliver to the parties of the first part the said wheat at their store house (Green Head) as or before the 15th day November 1877.
