Recd. This Deed made this 5th day of February 1857, between A. T. Ridley and
Lury A. his wife of County of Roanoke and of the first part and on the other
of the County of Suffolk of the second part, testifies: That for and in consideration of
the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the party of
the second part at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, the parties of the first part have given, granted
bargained and sold and do by these presents give, grant, bargain and sell unto the
party of the second part, with several warranty, all of a certain tract or lot of
land lying and being in the County of Roanoke and bounded as follows:
Beginning at a tree (common corner) for H. H. Jenkins, H. H. Uppenhauer
and A. T. Ridley's on the causeway branch, thence along a line of old trees to a stone
H. H. Uppenhauer and A. T. Ridley's a general corner on the road from the hamlet
to the Staunton River near A. T. Ridley's house, thence along said road on easterly
course to a stone corner, thence along the dividing line between A. T. Ridley and A. S.
Uppenhauer to a junction on the dividing branch in front of Mrs. Mary
Allison's house, thence down the dividing branch to a general corner near the line
and a general road and from A. T. Ridley's house to A. S. Uppenhauer's
line (and between the lands of A. T. Ridley and the lands of A. T. and A. S. Uppenhauer's
house) thence along and leading line to an east corner of A. T. Ridley's
