Morris of the second part, witnesses that in consideration of \$2.00 fifty dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the parties of the first part with good, lawful and full title to the parties of the second part, a certain tract or parcel of land with all the appurtenances thereto belonging, containing (9) nine acres in the second survey or l^y. said land lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, bounded as follows, viz. on the north and east by the land of George D. Davis; and the South and east by the two hands and ending, third and the other with said David being a part of the tract on which George D. Davis once owned and sold to the said Wth Morris by said Davis to have and to hold to the parties of the second part to her and her heirs to her and theirs use and the heirs forever.
