This Deed made and entered into the 19th of March 1797 betwixt Richard T. Johnson and Denny M. Johnson his wife grantors of the first part and George Drayton grantee of the second part, witnesseth: that for and in consideration of the sum of \$210 to the said Richard T. Johnson and Denny M. Johnson we have paid by the said George Drayton, they the said Richard T. Johnson and Denny his wife have given, granted, conveyed and sold unto the said George Drayton a certain tract of land lying in Southampton County, containing sixty acres more or less - bounded as follows: commencing at a corner near Lot 6, 67, 74 a line of marked trees to a corner point in the branch, thence S. E. along a branch to a corner point in the branch, thence north 67 6, straight line to a corner point in the field, thence a straight line to the first station, adjoining the land of John Kite, Richard Wardin and Mr. Stephenson and William Kithen and the said Richard T. Johnson and Denny his wife do warrant unto the said George Drayton the title generally to the said tract of land. At witness the following signatures and seals.

This Deed made the 29th day of March 1797 betwixt Bailey Bryant of the first part, and Sarah C. Bryant of the second part, both of Southampton County, State of Virginia, witnesseth: that the said Bailey Bryant for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred Dollars due by bond bearing date 1st day of January 1797; and whereas the said Bailey Bryant is indebted to indelibly, and show this debt hereby secured to the said Sarah C. Bryant: Also therefore the said Bailey Bryant had granted, conveyed and sold to the said Sarah C. Bryant the following property to wit: one horse, all my farming utensils, all my hogs, cows and swine household and kitchen furniture, 1 deer, 1 silver bowl, 2 double barrel shot guns all my corn, fodder, land and team to secure the above named debt.
