 assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton
 State of Virginia, and containing security five acres more or less, joining
 the land of J. S. Shop, W. Noble and others, being a part of the tract
 known as the said George's tract, to have had to hold the said tract or
 parcel of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him his heirs
 and assigns forever. And I hereby warrant and defend the title of said land.
