Conc. This Agreement entered into this 23rd day of November 1877, between James J. Appleswhite, a Justice of the Peace for the County of Southampton, and William C. Appleswhite of the other part, setting forth as follows: That whereas the said Wm. C. Appleswhite is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1877, from the said Appleswhite for the amount of fifty dollars beyond said amount he said Appleswhite shall not go, and the said Appleswhite having agreed and his part to furnish said supplies. Now the said Wm. C. Appleswhite in his part and in consideration of the above provisions do hereby grant a lien to the said Appleswhite and all the crops or his part all the crops which the said Appleswhite may make on his land during the year 1877, which the said Appleswhite will cultivate this year for the above amount of advances which has been intended to have been advanced: Now it is furthermore agreed by the said Appleswhite that he shall deliver enough of said crops to pay J. P. Appleswhite at Southampton County Va. to pay the above and to pay the 1st day of May next. This lien is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 3rd 1875 entitled an act to secure the debtors for agricultural purposes.
