This Agreement entered into this 31st day of March, 1797, between James J. Darden of the first part and Joseph C. Connelly of the other part, witnesses, as follows: That whereas the said Joseph C. Connelly is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and it desires to obtain supplies during the year 1797 from the said Darden for the amount of seventy five dollars beyond said amount he the said Connelly shall not pay, and the said Darden having agreed as his part to furnish said supplies, now the said Joseph C. Connelly do set forth and in consideration of the above provisions do hereby grant a lien to the said Darden on all of the crops he makes on the year 1797, and the year and on which the said Connelly lives: now for the above advance which has been or was intended to have been repaid: that it is furthermore agreed by the said Connelly that he shall deliver enough of said crops to Jas. J. Darden at whatever price he to pay the above and by or before the 1st day of December 1797. This lien is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 3rd 1793 entitled an act to secure the advances for agricultural purposes.
