sell all the property herein mentioned for cash, and out of the proceeds pay  
said debt, interest and costs, and balance of such proceeds pay over to  
the said Job Holland or his assigns.

and thousand eight hundred and seventy seven between H. A. Griffis, trustee of  
the first part and Job R. Edwards of the second part, both of the County  
of Southampton and State of Virginia, and W<sup>t</sup> Peatord, S. C.  
Edwards and C. C. Davis, merchants and factors in the City of Port-  
smouth under the name and style of Skinner, Edwards & Davis  
third part and John A. Cuthbert of the County of Southampton and State  
of Virginia, fourth part: Whereas by a deed dated the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May  
aforesaid of the fourth part: Whereas by a deed dated the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November  
in the year 1775 and of record in the Clerk's office of Southampton County  
between the said Job R. Edwards and Henry A. his wife wherein it is agreed to share to the  
sum of six hundred pounds sterling to the said Job R. Edwards, the premium of the sum of Two Thousand  
one hundred and fifty five £ 15/- per annum as reckoned by this note bearing date and  
the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May 1775 rendered by the said Job R. Edwards party of the  
first part and also to secure the said Job R. Edwards against  
any loss sustained by him in consequence of his nonpayment, did convey  
unto the said H. A. Griffis, trustee, in trust certain property situate  
and described in said Deed as follows: That certain land now let occur in
