dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the aforesaid Thos D. Butler  
and A. R. Christie trustees to her certain debt made by John & Willis to whom  
D. S. Cole debt of whom Thos D. Butler has now advantage after having on  
due notice by advertisement and proceeded to sell the estate described in his  
deed and Richard W. Clayton became the Purchaser at £500, five hundred  
dollars & hereby convey all right title and interest noted in it as such unto  
to the aforesaid A. W. Clayton of the second part.

C. & D. This Deed made the 16<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year 1777, between  
John D. Kitchens Commissioner in Ordinary of the County Court for the  
County aforesaid, and H. & J. Schell, Trustees  
of the other part, all of the County of Southampton Va. aforesaid,  
that the said H. & J. Schell will grant unto the said Thos D. S.  
Schell, (Master) the following property, to wit: All his household furni-  
ture; his C. & P. of horses, cattle, servants and cattle worth during the  
year 1776 and sum remaining on hand; all his stock consisting of  
cattle, sheep, lambs, hogs and swine, over 100 lbs of bacon, are to supply  
horses and cattle each day as much to receive the payment of the  
following debts; viz: one hundred and five £, dated 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1776  
due to Ed. G. Schell; also another bill of £100, due dated April 1<sup>st</sup>.
