Whereas by a deed of the Circuit Court of the County of Southampton, Virginia
made at the November Term 1875, in the cause therein pending wherein John R. Kelly
or is plaintiff and John C. Campbell personal representatives and others are defendants,
it was decreed and ordered that John R. Kelly, (who was appointed Commissioner for that
purpose) proceed to sell the land in the proceedings mentioned, whereof John C. Campbell
had right and interest, in the County of Southampton aforesaid, containing and con-
taining and thirty four acres, more or less, adjoining Greenock Swamp, and the same, and
decree, and whereas the said John R. Kelly, as Commissioner aforesaid, pursuant
to said decree did advertise the said land as directed, and did on the 19th day of
February 1876, (being County Court day) sell at auction before the Court House
door of said County, the said land and appurtenances, where the same was pur-
chased by Georgiana Johnson, Indiana Campbell, Mary Anne Pinner, and others Com-
missioners, (John C. Campbell and John C. Campbell) at the price of one hundred
dollars, (approx.) and of the purchase money paid in cash \$100, and received
three hundred and sixty six dollars, and two and three quarters after date,
respectively; and whereas under proceedings had in said Court, John R. Kelly,
as Commissioner aforesaid, has collected of said purchasers and paid over to the
creditors of said John C. Campbell, the amounts due them, having due the said
Commissioner the sum of \$36.32, and whereas by a deed made in said Court
at the November Term 1875 of said Court, it was decreed that the said John R.
Kelly, Commissioner aforesaid collect the said sum of \$36.32, and make a deed
for the said land with special warranty to the said Georgiana Johnson and Indiana
Campbell, they having found the owners of said land, and the other persons
having claim thereto that right to a deed is shown; and whereas the said Georgiana
Johnson and Indiana Campbell have paid the said sum of \$36.32: Therefore
This Deed, made this 19th day of July 1876, Whereas the said John R. Kelly, as
Commissioner aforesaid of the said Court, and the said Georgiana Johnson and
Indiana Campbell of the other part, witnesseth: that the said John R. Kelly,
as Commissioner aforesaid, in consideration of the premises then granted with
special warranty unto the said Georgiana Johnson and Indiana Campbell
and to their heirs and assigns forever, the land aforesaid and its appurten-
