Jenkins, Trustee, of said County and State of the second part, witnesseth. That for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars to him the said Mr. T. Scott paid, by the said T. Scott and his wife, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, to the said Mr. T. Scott doth quit, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Wm. G. Jenkins, with general warranty, all of that certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton Virginia, about three miles south of Franklin Depot, containing forty acres more or less and bounded as follows: On the north by Tetton Creek of land, now owned by S. Stephens (Col.), on the south by the lands of D. A. Setchell, on the east by the lands belonging to the estate of John G. Scott dec'd; and on the west by the Franklin and Setchell road, together with all the improvements thereon and appertaining thereto, I have and do hold the aforesaid tract of land to him the said Wm. G. Jenkins, trustee, his heirs and assigns forever. In Trust, to secure to him & Cutcher his payment of one hundred dollars to the said Mr. T. Scott for the sum of One Hundred Dollars and twenty days on the 11th day of May 1877 (being even date with this deed), and payable on the 31st day of December 1877. And the said party of the first part certifies that should he make default and fail to pay the aforesaid sum in accordance with the date and term above, then the said Party (Trustee) of the second part shall proceed to sell the same at public auction and apply the proceeds to the last debts.
