Comd. This Ord made this the 8th day of May in the year one thousand
and 87th Well eight hundred and seventy seven, between Delaware S. Well of the County
of Southampton of the one part and Frank Atkinson of the City of
Philadelphia and State of Pennsylvania, of the other part, certificate that
the said Delaware S. Well doth agree with the said Frank Atkinson the follow-
ing property, to wit: 1st a certain tract or parcel of land in the said
County of Southampton and State of Virginia, lying near Nettaway Station
on the Seaboard and Tidewater Rail Road, and adjoining the Nettaway Mill
R.R. track, and bounded as follows: Commencing at the head of the said Rail
Road, and running to a southerly direction along the eastern boundary of
Nettaway Mill track thirteen hundred and fifty feet; thence in an easterly
direction one hundred and thirty two feet, making a southerly boundary of
right angle with the before mentioned boundary into the Story track, thence
in southerly direction thirteen hundred and fifty feet, making an eastern
boundary of part of the Story track, to the head of the said Rail Road,
thence in a southerly direction, and bounded each thirty two feet along the
head of the said Rail Road, to the Commencing point, containing by estimate
