 for the year 1877 from the said Dorchester and Richard for the amount of
 forty four dollars, and Mrs. Phoebe Dagg for the amount of twenty five dollars, and
 Mrs. Phoebe Dagg for the amount of fifteen dollars, and for taking the same
 agreement and for each of the foregoing, and the said Dorchester and Richard, for
 Phoebe Dagg, has the said Arthur Leigh at his part and in consideration of the
 above mentioned debt hereby grants a loan to the said Dorchester and Richard, for
 the year 1877, and all the crops of corn, fodder, peas,
 and cotton together with any other money for the above amount of
 advances which has been made or ever intended to have been expended, and
 the said Arthur Leigh binds himself equally to pay to deliver said crops
 above mentioned to Dorchester and Richard and Mrs. J. Richard at fifteen cents
 per bushel, and before the 1st day of Nov. 1877. The loan is granted under and at
