This Agreement entered into this 9th day of June 1877, between Jas. J. Dandred of the first part and Thomas A. Bishop of the other part witnessed as follows, To wit: whereas the said Thomas A. Bishop is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1877 from the said Jas. J. Dandred for the amount of forty dollars and for taking the acknowledgment and for recording said agreement, and the said Jas. J. Dandred having on his part agreed to furnish said supplies, then the said T. A. Bishop on his part and in consideration of the above promises doth hereby agree and agrees to said Jas. J. Dandred, and enough payments made the year 1877 on the lands where the said Bishop now lives to pay the above amount, for the amount advanced to him this year which has been or was intended to have been acknowledged, and the said Bishop binds himself agreeable to law to deliver said payments also mentioned to Jas. J. Dandred at Richwood District W., by or before the 1st day of Jan'y 1878. And said Jas. J. Dandred under the Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2nd. 1874 entitled an act to secure the advances for agricultural purposes. Witness the following signatures.
