

This Agreement made and entered into, this 1st day of May 1877, between Wm. Edwards of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, of the first part, and Wm. McBeath & Co., of Jenkins Co. of the second part, whereas Wm. Edwards & Co., have advanced unto the said William Edwards eighty seven ⁴⁰four dollars in consideration by a note bearing date with this writing, and whereas the said Wm. McBeath & Co., agreed from time to time to make additional advances to and amongst not exceeding at all last hundred and twenty five dollars, to enable the said Wm. Edwards to carry on his farming operations and the lands owned by Wm. Ellen Sumner, and the above children of H. C. Joyce for the year 1877. Were therefore, in consideration of the sum advanced and further advanced agreed to be made from time to time, and the further consideration of one dollar to the said Wm. Edwards paid by Wm. McBeath & Co., the said Wm. Edwards hereby covenants and agrees that the advance shall constitute a lien upon all the crops of every description growing and to be planted and grown by the said Wm. Edwards. If the said Wm. Edwards shall fail on or before the 1st day of December 1877, to pay the said debt, then the said Wm. McBeath & Co., shall after ten days notice advertised and sell all the property herein conveyed for sale, and all of the proceeds from said debt, interest and costs, and balance of such proceeds they owe to the said Wm. Edwards or his assigns. Given under my hand this 1st day of May 1877.

Know all men by these presents, that S. Jacob Denner of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, that for and in consideration of forty five hundred and fifty (450) dollars to me in hand paid by Denner and Heyrick of the aforesaid County and State, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have long since and sold and forever quit claim to the said Denner & Heyrick of the following property, to wit: one bale of low middling cotton to waight up to and not exceeding and fifty (450) pounds to be delivered at Newmarket before 7th of which cotton is Virginian and is just as the present growing crop. Now I the said S. Denner do covenant and bind myself to deliver all of the above said cotton to the vendee Denner & Heyrick by or before the 1st day of November 1877, and after that time the said Denner and Heyrick shall have lawful right and full power to demand and receive payment of the said sum.
