This Deed, made this 5<sup>th</sup> day of June 1877, between William Porter grantor of  
the first part, and M. Edwards hisson as trustee (all of the County of Southampton  
State of Virginia) witnesses: that the said William Porter did grant, bargain  
and sell unto the said M. Edwards the following personal property, to wit: the  
said William Porter's entire crop of corn, wheat, cotton and peanuts which he  
is cultivating on the farm belonging to J. L. Edwards lying in the aforesaid  
County of Southampton - said crops to be delivered as soon as they can be gathered  
untill the said trustee, or in the event that the said Porter shall for any reason  
fail to gather them, then, said trustee shall sell them at the premises at any time  
after Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> 1877, all of said property conveyed in trust to secure the following  
debt for rent due unto the said J. L. Edwards dated Oct. 16, 1877 and due as of before  
November 1<sup>st</sup> 1877, for one hundred and twenty five dollars (\$125).

ampton State of Virginia, that for and in consideration of one hundred dollars to  
the said Mayor paid by Dondos and Keyick and Jas. J. Dondos of the above said  
County and State, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold  
and conveyed unto the said Dondos and Keyick and Jas. J. Dondos of the  
following property, to wit: two lots of low land, situate lying north by land  
450 feet and each to be delivered at Newmarket District Va., which lot is over-  
grown and excepting out the present growing crop, the proceeds of which cotton  
shall be divided proportionably between Dondos and Keyick and Jas. J. Dondos,  
then, the said Dondos do covenant and bind myself to deliver all of the above  
mentioned lot to the said Dondos and Keyick and Jas. J. Dondos by or  
before the first day of November 1877, and after that time the said Dondos and  
Keyick and Jas. J. Dondos shall have full, right and full power to de-  
mand and defend possession of the same.
