Whithead is about to engage in the cultivation of the land for the amount of twenty five hundred acres, for the year 1877 from the said Jas. J. Gordon, for working this agreement, and the said Jas. J. Gordon, having in his mind, agreed to furnish land in place, the said Jas. J. Gordon, having in his mind, consideration of all other previous debt hereby grant a Lien to the said Jas. J. Gordon, on his crops of cotton and corn which he is cultivating on the land, and on the land of the said Jas. J. Gordon, which has been or was intended to have been expended, with the said Whithead, bonds, payable to him to deliver said crops above mentioned to the said Jas. J. Gordon at Williams Dept. Va., by or before the 1st day of August 1877. This deed is granted under and Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, passed April 23^d 1874, entitled and to be second advance for crop of cotton and corn. Whereby the following signatures,

Wiley Smith, Deed, of the other part, witnesses, that the said Whithead did grant with the said Smith each general warranty the following property, to wit, one bay mare, one hegg and all his former estate and all the crops of every description now growing and to be grown during the year 1877 on the plantation known as "Hards Road Plant" in Southampton Co., Va. on which plantation said mare, hegg and estate were at the time, to secure to the said Smith the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars to be advanced, as cash or supplies or both, by the said Whithead. M. Edwards to said Jas. Whithead during the year 1877 for the purpose of aiding said Whithead in his farming operations during said year.
