Stephens, Report, on consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars in support of the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have given, bargained and sold and sold and by their private contract, bargain and sale deed, bearing date the 10th day of August, 1887, District School Trustees for District No. 2, in the County and State aforesaid the following property, to wit: the several acres more or less of land situate in their tract, and building thereon and used for some time past as a house of worship for the Baptist Church at Sayre, Report, on trust to, to wit and conveyed for the benefit of the public school in District No. 2, in Southwestern County, in the County and State aforesaid and agreed that the said Church trustees only owning the building on the said land and not any part of the said land, the said land having already by this deed been conveyed to the said school trustees and the said house being hereupon considered personal or chattel property, subject to the following conditions, to wit:
