Crishton, of the second, witnesses: that whereas, the said Seth H. Crishton is engaged in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1877, from the said J. C. Norrell and Co., for the amount of thirty (\$30.00) dollars, and the said J. C. Norrell and Co., having agreed to furnish said supplies, and in consideration of the above advances and promises, the said Seth H. Crishton does hereby grant a lien to the said J. C. Norrell and Co., on all the crops which may be made during the year 1877, upon the land which the said Seth H. Crishton does cultivate or hereafter be cultivated by tenants, for the amount of above advances. And it is further agreed by the said parties to this agreement, that the crops above referred to is to be delivered to the said J. C. Norrell & Co., on or before the 1st day of November 1877.
