Pope (Master) of the second, both of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, witnesses that for each consideration of the sum of twelve hundred and forty two dollars and thirty six cents (\$1242.²⁶) to me Joseph Reuter in hand paid by the said J. C. Pope I hereby grant and convey unto the said J. C. Pope all of my present growing crop, consisting of cotton, corn, fodder and beans; also my stock of hogs and their increase. So much, however, to secure one bond dated the 25th day of Feb. 1876, for \$125.00, one other dated 1st day of June 1877, and also to secure the interest year account for fertilizer &c., and placed at first - the above bond and debt J. C. Pope is discharging. And it is agreed by the parties to this deed that should any debt there enter into it, it shall only be after 30 days notice of time and place, and the Master shall be entitled to 5% cost on goods sold.
