

This Deed made the 5<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy seven between John A. Garret Peeler and N. Virginia Peeler of the first party, and John Peeler Senior of the other party, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesses that the said parties of the first part (for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars in hand paid by the said party of the second part to the said parties of the first part, the receipt of which said is hereby acknowledged,) do grant and convey unto the said John Peeler Senior, with general warranty, the following tract or parcels of land to wit: all of the right, title and interest of the said A. Garret Peeler in and to that tract or parcel of land lying in said County, at the west side of the Road leading from Jessup to Smithfield, and bounded as follows, on the South by the lands of Henry A. Williams, on the West by the lands belonging to the estate of George Paquet, John Scarrow and the lands of Thomas J. Peeler Senior, and the Road leading to Petersburg, and on the South by the lands of the said A. C. Peeler, supposed to contain two hundred and forty acres more or less; and all of the said A. C. Peeler's interest in and to the following tract lying in said County, and bounded as follows, to wit: on the North by the lands of David Jones, to the east by the Jessup and Smithfield Road, on the South by the lands of Edwin A. Williams and Henry A. Williams, and on the west by the lands of Moses Jones, supposed to contain one hundred and fifty acres more or less - the east end of the said tract A. C. Peeler being now joined in the said two tracts of land, as one of the heirs of Thosas J. Peeler deceased - the first described tract being a part of the tract formerly owned by Elijah Davis, and the second by Eli Frashaw and Tobias A. Williams.
