Gordon, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, a certain Part of Smith given and accepted by William Bay of Southampton County, said State of Virginia to said Samuel Kelly on a certain tract of lands lying in said Southampton County State of Virginia, bounded by lands of Walter, Kirkwin, Kelly and the Public Road to descend the sum of Eleven Hundred and Sixty Nine Dollars and Seventy three cents (\$1169.73) and thereas more particularly described.
