Pope a tract of land for the survey of fifteen hundred (1500) dollars payable on demand, and whereas the said Wm. H. Cull did execute a deed of deed to the said James R. Barden, dated on 22nd day of Decr. 1797, of the following described tract of land to secure the payment of said land, bounded and described as follows, to wit: the south by the land of Wm. H.
