This Book reads the 19th day of May in the year 1777, between J. L. Harrison and Virginia & his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and R. Giffen, Justice of said County and State of the second part, witnessed: that for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars to them in hand paid by the said R. Giffen, Justice, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, they the said parties of the first part do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, all of that certain tract or parcel of land lying the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, containing by estimation eighty acres more or less, and bounded by a line, commencing at a red oak, a few rods off line bett between Carr Seale and William Seale, thence along a line of marked trees to a fork oak, a corner for the White New river tract, on Carr Seale, thence along a line of marked trees
