This Deed made this the 16th day of Nov. 1877, between Wm. H. Coll and Mary Ann his wife, of the County of Surfer in the State of Virginia, of the one part, and Richard H. Rollings of the County of Southampton, Virginia, of the other part, witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred and seventy five dollars, the said Wm. H. Coll and Mary Ann his wife do grant and convey unto the said Richard H. Rollings the following tract or parcel of land, containing three hundred and fifty five acres, it being a portion of the land purchased by the said Wm. H. Coll from the estate of A. S. Loggans dead, and bounded as follows, on the South by the path running through what is called the "Loggans" field, and the land of Harris Turner, and the land formerly belonging to Richard Williams dead, on the East by the land of A. H. Williams, on the West by the land of J. H. Williams, on the North by the old mill race, and on the West by a new line commencing about fifty yards from the old mill house and running a track westerly across to the path mentioned above running through the "Loggans" field, to hold to him and his heirs forever and the said Wm. H. Coll do hereby warrant and guarantee the aforesaid land to the said Richard H. Rollings.
