This Deed made this 17th day of December one thousand eight hundred and seventy seven, between Richard A. Rollings of the one part, and William H. Butler, Executor of the other part, witnesseth: that the said Richard A. Rollings did grant and the said W. H. Butler, Executor, did certain tract or parcel of land containing three hundred and fifty five acres, more or less, situate in the County of James late bought of B. B. Cuthbert, bounded as follows: to wit the South by the path running through what is called the Utopians' field and the lands of Harris Street, and the land formerly belonging to Richard Williams dead, on the East by the land of A. Williams, on the North by the old Mill race, and the West by a new line, commencing about fifty yards from the Mill house and running a South easterly course to the path mentioned above running through the Utopians' field, in trust, to secure a note of Sir Rowland Ballantyne and due this day to Richard Bantshaw. The Conditions of this deed are as follows: Should the aforesaid note be paid when demanded, with cost of and interest thereon, this deed will be null and void, otherwise W. H. Butler, Executor, after giving twenty days notice by advertisement, will proceed to sell the same on the premises for cash for any the said note, interest and charges of sale, and cost of all looking laws; the balance if any, to be paid over to the said R. A. Rollings or his legal representatives. Witness the following signature and seal:
