 against of the debt and such heres inheritance and benefit, and the sum of one dollar to
 them paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby is a return
 made to by three private grants, bargain and sell convey and confirm, with the said
 party of the second part, the following described real estate, situated, lying and being
 in the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, to wit: one hundred and thirteen acres
 of land, the said land is the land which was allotted to the Sarah S. Carr at her death
 and is bounded by the lands of Lewis Moore, Harriett D. Pipe and others So have and
 to hold the said land unto the party of the second part, his heirs or assigns, and to hold,
 however, for the following purposes: to wit, as the parties of the first part had the
